

# WHAT MARRICKVILLE METRO ARE DOING TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

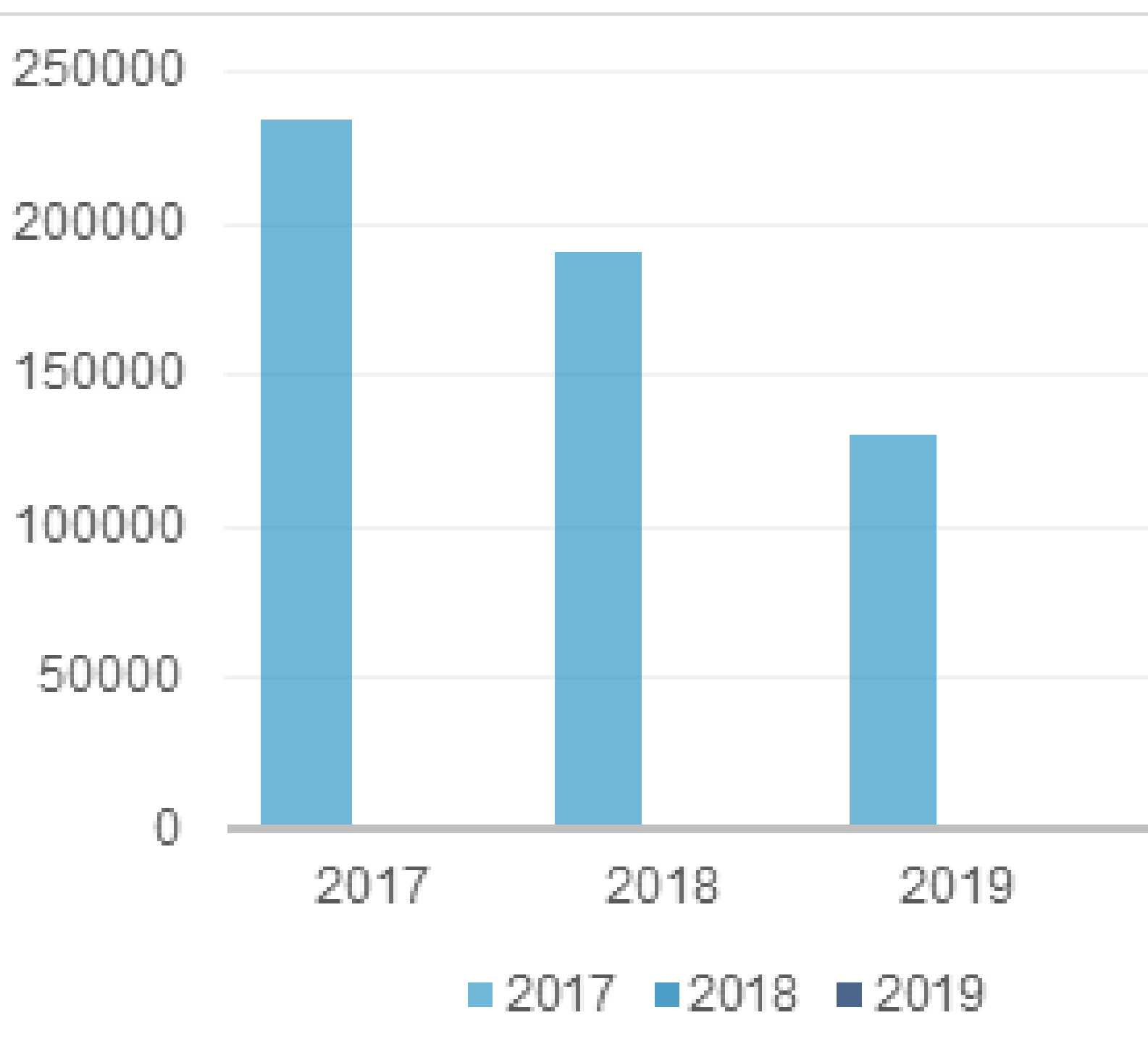
## INTRODUCTION

## THE STATISTICS

Since completing a major LED lighting upgrade throughout the Centre in late 2018, including the under cover carpark, fire escapes, external perimeter and internal mall bulkheads, Marrickville Metro saw a reduction of a staggering 164,407 KWH of energy consumption in 2019. **See below for energy consumption (KWH) between 2017 - 2019.**



## SOME FACTS

In March 2018, Marrickville Metro was sitting on a 2.5 Star NABERS Energy Rating. In April 2019, that rating had risen to 3.5 Stars and Marrickville Metro is currently tracking towards a 4 Star rating in 2020.
